The promotion of health and wellbeing in children and young people is paramount for preventing long term mental health problems. Therefore, as part of the government's brand new initiative we are delighted to be part of the new Mental Health Support Team working in the Bradford East area.

The team work on a 1:1 basis with children and young people who are presenting with mild to moderate mental health issues. We have a variety of interventions which would be suitable for young people experiencing things such as Low Mood, Anxiety, Phobias, Anger/Irritablitiy and Sleep problems. We also work with parents/careers for a number of interventions including Parent Led CBT and our parenting programme for conduct problems.

As well as 1:1 interventions we implement a Whole School Approach within our settings - working with all staff, parents and pupils. We work closely with schools to help them identify social, emotional and mental health issues as early as possible using our consultation/advice offer.
