

#DataSavesLives – New Connected Health Research Project in Bradford

- Connected Bradford is a new project that connects local health and education information so that NHS researchers can provide the best possible care for children and their parents.
- Our aim is to improve the health and wellbeing of children.
- Our research database brings together information from GP practices in Bradford and Airedale with information from other parts of the health and education system, such as Bradford Teaching Hospitals and Bradford Local Authority or the Department for Education. This helps us understand where we can improve care for patients.
- Information about you will be anonymised before it is used for research. This ensures that we cannot identify you. We collect information on children across Bradford and Airedale who have a date of birth from 01 January 1988 to all new school entrants.
- Information will be anonymised before it is used for research and to improve health and education services. This means we cannot identify you.
