Take part in a 3-minute survey about current practices across Bradford, asking

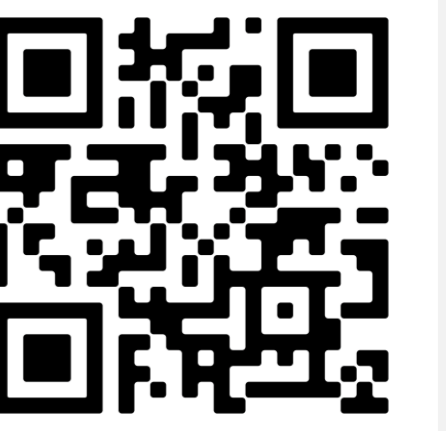
- Which **reading comprehension tests** are used in your school?
